- 2 Goals: 1st Increase the number of K-3 students who are at or above the benchmark of 63%, goal of 75%. We met goal! 2nd – Math – 4th/5th will reach EOY growth goal on Math Map, we had 72% and they met their goal.
- Acadience Growth – Saw a rise of students at or above.
- MAP is taking 3 times per year, one one-on-one with teacher.
- KG – 5th Growth & Achievement
- **CMAS** – Is taken in the Spring. We saw incredible growth in students, 4th went from 45% to 67 %, Reading 46.5% to 63.2% and Math 3rd no growth but growth in 4th & 5th
- **Performance framework:** We are at 91.9 Points! Kids here are growing. There were seven schools in Jeffco that were above 65th percentile and we were one of them!
- This year's current data: Reading Map Testing. Math 48%, K-5 above 60th percentile. Reading 47% - students are above 60th percentile, last year 58% were above.
- Dibels: 37% of students are at or above benchmark. There has been a lot of change in the test so this is why we see a lower percentile. We still have already seen a lot of growth.
- ILT Retreat: Reviewed data to set goals. New goals are:
 - 60% of all K-3rd will be at or above benchmark on Dibels
 - 65% of 4th-5th will reach their growth goal on Math MAP. (Growth goal doesn't mean non-academic achievement.)

- KG-Choice Info. night scheduled for November 30th.
- The district is changing the choice rules. A family can only apply to three schools, not as many as they want. This will allow schools to do some realistic planning.
