Start of School Update:

- Enrollment at 326, budgeted for 332 – negative 42,000 October adjustment.
- New Staff – Kindergarten, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, Learning Specialist, DTL, ESL, SEL, Sch. Psych., FEL, Several Paras
- FEL – Role – to help with community participation and to help increase participation with events. Help create assured equity, help families with learning, and help families with language barriers.
- Clubs/PLC's – Classes are assigned to an AMP class and they will do that club for a whole trimester. The students will be in a different club for each trimester. These clubs are 45 minutes per week, not daily.

School Procedure Reminders:

- Hug-N-Go: Review expectations. Stay on the curb and keep moving.
- Front Door & Vestibule – everyone needs to sign in, even if you just want to walk your student to the classroom first thing in the morning.
- Office & classroom communications. Teachers will send out weekly, biweekly or monthly classroom news. Anne sends out a weekly messenger that goes to everyone's email on Fridays at 5:00 p.m.

Construction Update:

- Beam signing – all students will sign a beam that will be placed on the south side of the construction for all to see, to commemorate.
- Construction was delayed due to weather and permitting issues.
- The new playground will open on September 18, and we will celebrate with popsicles.
- The exterior walls will be going up this month.
- They are building an outdoor amphitheater structure on the hill north of the new addition. It can be used as another outdoor teaching space, etc.
- Parking – they will be adding about 10 additional parking spots.
- The anticipated completion date is January/February 2024.
- Science Lab/STEM Lab will be going into the 1st Temp after the 2nd grade moves into the building.
